



On behalf of Grain Growers and L A Judge Memorial Award, the NBIA is seeking potential Queensland participants for the 2020 Sydney Competition.

The L A Judge Award was established in 1967, this Award is a prestigious national annual event, which recognises the best young baking apprentices in Australasia. Competitors can enter as either an Australian or New Zealand representative. These young bakers' skills are evaluated in areas of practical baking, technical knowledge and communication abilities over the three-day competition.

Criteria to compete in L A Judge Award competition:

- Participant must be aged 23 or younger as of January 1st in the year you plan to compete (2020).
- Participant must be working in the baking industry.

Scoring Method:

Scoring is split into three categories:

- Practical baking skills - 50% of the total mark
- Technical knowledge - 25% of the total mark
- Presentation & communication skills - 25% of the total mark

Selection Process – Queensland Participant

Applicants seeking to represent Queensland will be required to attend a bake-off selection process that will be held from 10th to 11th December 2019 (you will only be required to attend on one day over this period).
